Citt Williams is an independent filmmaker currently completing her Ph.D. at RMIT University's Digital Ethnography Research Center. With degrees from East Anglia University and Oxford University, her expertise lies at the intersection between filmmaking, environmental science and policy development. Citt has spent the past year based in the bush in Northern Queensland filming the

impact of climate change in the context of aboriginal seasonal calendars.

Throughout her career, Citt has developed and shot documentaries in India, Nepal, Tajikistan, Siberia, Japan, Papua New Guinea, France, Borneo and Australia.

In this invited lecture, Citt will situate audio video media production within the academy, and explore its relevance to communication for change within an environmental sustainability context. She will elaborate the importance of media campaigns targeted at key global audiences to achieve policy goals and action.
