In this invited lecture, Luis will talk about his experiences working with scientists and how video documentaries can enhance the communication of their work. He will explore the impact of several internationally acclaimed documentaries that have influenced our world and raised awareness of major social issues.

Luis will explain the critical role that scientists play as communicators, campaigners and protagonists participating in and shaping global debates.
